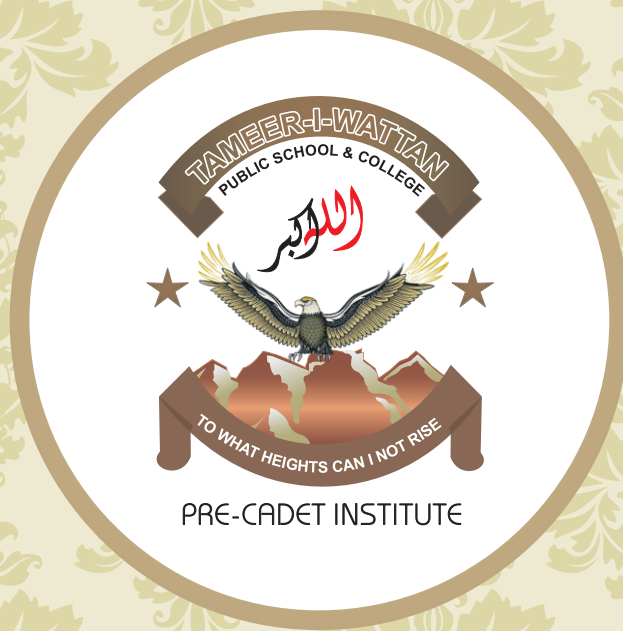

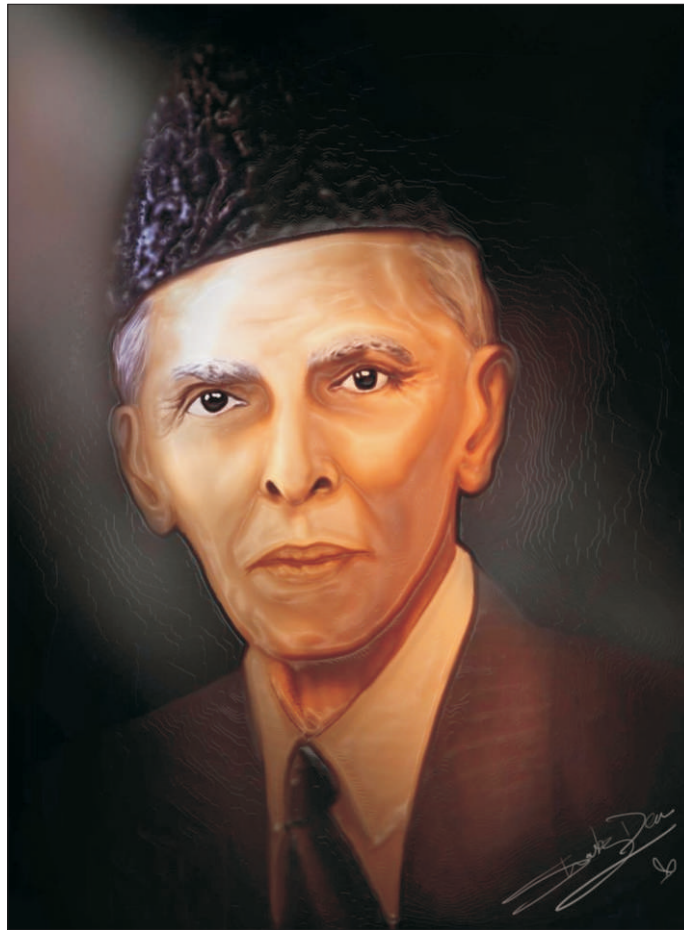

ORGANIZATION

Tameer-i-Wattan an immense academic entity is being managed by BOG, holding regular meetings to discuss the progress of the institutions and to guide the first line administration, the principal and other high slotted officers.

The organization constitutes huge administrative network including executive director, administrator cum principal, principal staff officer, vice principals, director academics (all campus) assistant coordinators, senior house master, assistant house masters, clerical staff and class VI, nursing staff, duty officers, admin officers, accounts manager, assistant accountant ect. A well qualified faculty selected purely on merit is also toiling hard to accomplish the sacred mission of character building of Tameerians through education.

ADMISSIONS

The institution offers admission to the applicants fulfilling the eligibility criteria of admission. The entry is through a test, based on the course of study, meant for the previous class and interview. However, for Prep and Nursery classes. There are just aptitude/intelligence/picture tests coupled with an interview to assess that the child will be able to benefit from this type of education and is fit for a resident institution. The entry test is organized every year in main campus Abbottabad. Induction system constitutes entry test followed by interviews. Candidates scoring less than 60% in entry tests will not be eligible for admission in school/college. Admission will be purely on merit and according to seats availability. Result of the test cannot be challenged under any circumstances. The test is held on 5th February every year. An advertisement to this effect appears in the prominent English/Urdu dailies of Pakistan through which applications for admission are called for.

DOCUMENTS:

1. Admission form duly completed in all respect must be handed over to the administration staff on the date of entry test along with following documents.
 - a. Photo copy Form B/Birth Certificate issued by NADRA.
 - b. 2x latest passport size photographs.
 - c. Photo copy of CNIC (Father). In case father is not alive, CNIC guardians are accepted.
2. Following documents must be provided after confirmation of admission.
 - a. School leaving Certificate (in original) duly signed by concerned board.
 - b. Copy of DMC's for class 9th to 2nd Year.
 - c. Migration certificate (In original) of other /local board.
 - d. For "O" Level Students, they will provide Equivalence certificate obtainable from Inter Board Committee of Chairman (IBCC) at FBISE Islamabad.
 - e. Scholarship students will also deposit their Original DMC's, which will be returned to the students after completion of 2nd Year.
 - f. Affidavit on stamp paper as per specimen.

ELIGIBILITY

For admission to any class, a candidate must either be studying in that class or must have passed the lower class preferably from an English medium institution. The candidate must be medically fit. Own students (play group to intermediate) who have appeared in annual exam will be granted admission on their performance in annual examination. Score less than 60% in annual exams will not be forwarded for admission in new class.

Age Limits

The prescribed age Limits on 1st March of the year of admission to various class are as follow.

The physical appearance of the candidate must correspond with the age mentioned in the application form.

APPLICATION FORM

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS:

The application form is a part of the school prospectus, that may be purchased on a cash payment of Rs. 1000/- or by sending a crossed bank draft payable to the principal of Rs. 1200/- Application for the admission must reach the year during which the admission is required. These must be accompanied with a crossed bank draft for Rs. 1200/- which is non refundable, as registration fee. The fees can also be paid in cash but not through money order. Applications which are not accompanied by the Registration fee will not be entertained. The admission is given on "first come, served" basis-cum performance in the entrance test and interview etc.

Application for admission must be submitted on a prescribed admission form appended to the prospectus. Application form must be correctly & completely filled and accompanied by documents demand of school administration.

Documents must be completely provided to administration before joining the class after the confirmation of the admission. On the basis of incomplete documents institution has the authority not to permit the student in the class.

THE MEDIUM OF CLASSROOM TEACHING

To ensure that our students may compete in English dominated international milieu the classroom language is English. To promote the ability to speak more fluently the mutual instructions among students, teachers and administration are accosted in English. Students are lured to take active part in English essay, story writing, declamation and rewarded by administration exceptional performance in competitions. The boarders are groomed in proper officers environment to learn the modern etiquette to learn an officer look and lunch.

BOOKS AND STATIONARY

The school and college have its own well-stocked books and stationery stores available. The students are not allowed to keep/ use exercise books other than those specially made/printed for School/College and issued by stationery store. It is school/college's responsibility to see that their prices are not more than that of the market.

CLASS ROOM

The college has sufficient number of classrooms, well spacious and well furnished to facilitate the students to get education in a suitable and comfortable atmosphere.

WASH ROOM

A sufficient number of toilets are available to the students built on standard scale.

CLEANLINESS

A huge fleet of sanitary staff remains on toe to provide filth free clean and healthy environment in the college.

COMPUTER LITERACY

To equip the students with modern technology and make them competent in the race of modern era especially in the field of computer education; the institute has a well equipped set up and sophisticated computer lab for boarders as well as day scholars. After the inclusion of Computer science as a subject for Matric & F.Sc, we have also included Computer Training in our scheme of studies, as an optional/elective subject both for the senior and junior classes. Internet facilities also exist in both the institutions.

THE STUDENT MESS

College has separate mess for boys and girls the menu is set according to the dietary requirements of the students. The mess is being run by a mess committee headed by PMC and assisted by a mess secretary.

THE SECURITY SYSTEM

The college premise is fortified with strong walls further secured with barbed wire and being secured by huge number of armed security guards well trained in their trade craft to protect the human assets of the Institution.

HOUSES

Rapid increase in boarders students there are many houses adorned with all the facilities keeping in view the comfort of the boarder students to provide student home like environment.

Each house is supervised by a competent house master assisted by AHns. Each house has proper study hours to prepare them understand the syllabus better. The boarders are taking part in sports.

CLUB

To spur the talent of Tameerians the club (d) Drama Club under the supervision of experienced staff the students well take part in different creative and healthy activities.

TRAINING AIDS

To make the teaching and pedagogical process more effective and powerful to inculcate the best of method in an easiest way, the av-aids are used for the quick understanding in classroom. The girls and boys institutions have their own well sophisticated laboratories, charts and experimental materials in their laboratories, which can be rightly called the pride of any educational institution. Besides these, there are view-graphs, projectors and frequent out door discussions to make class work interesting and stimulating.

PHYSICAL TRAINING

Physical training is considered an important factor in the character building and grooming a child. We have well-trained and experienced staff who impart physical training and ensure proper order and discipline during collective outdoor activities which is a part of the school and college time-table. Special coaching is available in various games and sports in the after-noon, including Gymnastics, Judo Karate, and Shooting etc.

RELIGIOUS TRAINING

Being conscious of the fact, that our country is an ideological state, and that our faith in Islam has to be instilled in our lives and particularly our educational system, special attention is given to religious education lying greater emphasis on Islamic principles of tolerance, universal brotherhood and mutual respect as a human being to the students having different faith. There are four Islamiyat teachers, having Masters degrees in Islamic Studies and Arabic and two qualified/trained "Qaris". All the children (Boarders) are taught Nazira-Quran (in addition to the normal course in Islamiyat) in the afternoon. The College has its own mosque. Administration arranged Shab-e-Jumma very week for boarders.

CO-CURRICULAR GROOMING

Realizing the same from last year college has established a separate directorate under a senior professor as director tutorials and co-curricular wing. Last year English/Urdu declamation were held. The Iqbal day was celebrated where the students proved their skills to sing the Kalam-e-Iqbal in such a way that audience seemed enchanted.

MEDICAL FACILITIES

Health is the greatest blessing of God. Healthy mind requires a sound body. For the sound health of the students the school and college have their own infirmaries i.e. small hospital. The students, particularly the Boarders with minor ailments, are kept in them. Qualified and experienced Nursing Staff looks after the sick children, while a part time qualified and experienced doctor, visits the school/college regularly. However, cases of serious illness are referred to the specialists and admitted to the Officers Ward of CM/Civil/Private and other quality Hospitals. The parents are informed only in case of serious / prolonged illness. The medical bills are paid by school but charged from the parents at the end of quarter along with the quarterly fee. A sum of Rs. 100/- is charged for routine medicines/preventives etc.



ATTENDANCE

Punctuality is the backbone of any field of life; achievement and accomplishment is the product of regularity. Observing the gravity of the major offence of missing the classes, the education code, as well as the Board's Calendar (BISE Abbottabad) have laid down that a student who has less than 75 % of possible attendance, counted from the date of the commencement of the academic session, or the date of his/her admission to the school, in case of new admission, may not be allowed to take the annual examination. Therefore, we consider that complete class attendance is primary to learning and punctuality is the bedrock of discipline. On our part, the School and College have taken further strict measures to curb absenteeism. These measures are as follows.

- a. Attendance in class is recorded twice a day in the morning assembly and then after the recess.
- b. Leave for absence has to be applied for in advance writing and the application, written in ink, should be duly signed by the parent/guardian.
- c. Application for medical must be delivered personally by the parent/guardian to eliminate the chances of malingering.
- d. Name of boys absenting themselves without valid reason for three (3) consecutive days or a broken period of five (5) days or more in one half of a term are liable to be struck off the school/college rolls and will have to seek re-admission.
- e. In the process of readmission, the student may also miss the Mid-term or End-term exam. As per our new marking system, the marks of each of the four exam in a session will now contribute to the core of the final exam thus, the absence from anyone exam would substantially decrease the chances of passing at the end of the year.
- f. Students of college sections who remains frequently absent from the class, during the term will not be allowed to continue their studies in the college and their Admission form will be with drawn and the student will not be allowed to take the examination.
- g. A fine of Rs. 50/- per day is levied for absence without leave in case of Day Boarder/ Day Scholar , and Rs. 100/- per may be imposed for absence immediately after the vacation/holidays and in case of college students any day of the year.
- h. Late comer will be fine Rs. 100 per day & casual student will be fined heavily and will be given warning letters leading to expulsion from the school/ college.
- i. After the three warning letters the student will be expelled from the college/School on the disciplinary grounds showing the irregularity in the attendance.
- j. Telephonic information about the leave will be entertained only in case of emergency.



FEE STRUCTURE

In case of the Boarding School, the fees are required to be paid on yearly basis. But for the convenience of the parents these are charged, on quarterly basis in advance. There is no question of remission in fee for the periods when the institution is closed. The last dates for payment of the fee without fine are.

(a) 1st quarter 10th March (b) 2nd quarter 10th June (c) 3rd quarter 10th September (d) 4th quarter 10th December

FEE RULES

1. A boarder, who joins late, has to pay full fee for the quarter during which he joins, as well as 20% of the total fee for all the months of the academic year for which he/she has not paid in his/her previous school. A student, who has not attended any school/college from the beginning of the year shall be charged full tuition fee for the entire year, as per govt rules.
2. For Board classes, the students have to pay the school fees (Boarders / Day scholars and Day Boarders) until the last month/quarter in which his/her name remains in the school /college rolls, including all the examination days and practical.
3. Fees, once paid, including those paid in advance, are not refundable. Except Security amount.
4. Additional, amount of Rs. 200/- is charged from students who take up computers as science subject or as a hobby.
5. Boarding charges include tuition, but exclude clothing, traveling, medicines, dry cleaning, haircut, Dhobi charges, test Books, Stationary, Heating, Examination Fee, Extra School charges etc.

Note: All the above fees are subject to revision without prior notice to the parents, but only if the pay grades are revised by the govt end/or the prices of consumer goods go up considerably.

FEE CONCESSION

Concessions in fees are.

- a. The Principal, at his discretion, and that too in very special cases, may allow full or part fee concession to any student of the school/college with Executive Director's prior written approval.
- b. **NO** concession in the fee is allowed for any period of absence due to any reason. For this purpose, a student will be deemed to have attended the school even if he/she is physically not present in the class till such time that he/she is not withdrawn.
- c. Third child will be granted 50% fee concession.

LATE FEE

Students who fail to pay their fees on due date are fined as follows.

- A sum of Rs. 50/- per day is charged as late fee from the Boarders till the last day of the quarter i.e. 10th March, 10th June, 10th September and 10th December for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th quarters respectively.
- In case of the Day Boarders and day Scholars, the fee must be paid by the 5th of every month, after which a late fee fine of Rs 20/- per day will be charged till the end of the month, after which the student's name will be struck off the school/college rolls.
- On no account a student's name can be kept on the school/college rolls, if his/her fee remains unpaid even after the above dates. Re-admission will be on discretion of the Principal and payment of re-admission fine.

REMITTANCE OF FEE & FUND

Payment must be made in Pakistani Rupees or equivalent foreign currency calculated on the value of the date of receipt. The fees must be remitted through the safest and faster means as follows.

- The fees will be remitted to the Principal through a crossed bank draft in favour of the payee's only. Cheques are not accepted. Fee may also be paid in cash to the Allied Bank Bara Tower Branch, Abbottabad. But it may not be remitted through money order.
- It will be the parent's own responsibility to obtain a proper receipt, particularly for the cash payment by bank.

When remitting the fee through post, the student's name, class and the quarter for which the fee is being paid, must be mentioned in the covering letter or on the reverse of Bank Draft.

POCKET MONEY

Students up to class V are not allowed to have any cash with them, nor may they be given any money by their parents/visitors. A sum of Rs.1000/- per term or Rs. 5000/- per annum should be deposited with the House Master/Mistress. They are allowed to make purchases out of this account twice a week under the supervision of the school staff, Money orders are NOT accepted.

Students in higher classes i.e. class VI up ward, should deposit the cash with their House Master and get it from him, Whenever required. The House Master will maintain a separate account for each student and deposit the entire amount in the pocket money account of their house, or may receive it through visitor's money orders. They are allowed to keep an account with the school canteen but may not spend more than Rs. 150/- per month. It is the school/college responsibility to ensure that the school canteen supply things of good quality and charges reasonable rates.

LETTERS WRITING

Every Boarder is persuaded to write at least one letter every week to his parents/guardian on their present address given in the admission form, any change in address should be communicated to the school/college by the parents / guardians, in writing at their earliest convenience. They are also advised to write to the children quite frequently all their letters should be replied as promptly as possible. Official correspondence is also made on this address. The school/college welcomes at least occasional letters from the parents/guardians enquiring into the health welfare and progress of their children/wards. It is in the best interest of the students if there is a regular contact between the school/college and parents in this

PARENT-TEACHER MEETINGS

It is a pristine fact that good working relationship between parents and teachers is one of the strong pillars on which an educational institute stands for the achievement of academic excellence.

It is needless to say that the first learning institute for a child is a mother's lap whereas; a teacher not only flourishes the mind but also uplifts a child spiritually. therefore, the combination of parents and teacher's edification for the child reaches to the climax of understanding and development.

Keeping in mind the importance of parents-teachers role Tameer-i-Wattan Public School & College conducts parents Teachers meetings on regular basis.

JOURNEY TO COLLEGE/HOME

It will be the responsibility of the parents/guardians to arrange safe journey for their sons/wards for going home and coming back to the College at the beginning and end of breaks/holidays. However, where possible, the college may arrange journey by rail/road/air of the students in groups on behalf of the parents/guardians. The College will adopt all possible measures for the safety of the Students during their stay at the College Campus. However, the College shall not be held responsible for any kind of accidents/mishaps causing any kind of physical harm or injury.



CHANGE IN BOARDER/DAY BOARDER STATUS

Please note that a student, who is admitted as Boarder/Day Boarder, is not subsequently allowed to shift over to Day Scholar at least for two years, because there are separate seats as well as selection criteria for admission to both the school/college. Change of seat from one to the other is not possible for at least one study session of two years. Anyone who does not want to continue as a Boarder or Day Boarder in spite of the 2-years restriction will automatically stand withdrawn from the school/college on receipt of application for the change.

AWARDS

On successful completion of the prescribed course of study, students are promoted to the higher class attached of academic year. Those attaining top positions are awarded prizes and merit certificates. Following medals are awarded on the annual parent's day and prize distribution ceremony.

- Gold medals are awarded to students scoring 95% and above in annual examination (Play group to class 8th) while in case of SSC students are awarded gold medals having marks 470 and above in board examination in the year and HSSC-I students scoring 440 in board examination will be awarded gold medal.
- Silver medal are awarded to students having percentage 90% to 94.99% in annual examination (Play group to Class 8th)
- Medal stars are awarded for position holder students in SSC and HSSC annual board examinations.
- Laptops are awarded for position holder in SSC-I and HSSC-I annual board examinations.
- Ummrah & Hajj Tickets are awarded for topper students in SSC & HSSC annual board examination.
- Merit certificates are awarded to high achiever students according to criterion laid by college administration.

SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES

- Scholarship will be given to the students of Class 6th to class 9th (New) (Internal/out coming) who secure decided percentage in the College/School entrance test according to the policy laid by administration. According to the seats announced by institution. After filling the seats no admission will be done on scholarship seat. Admission will be on scholarship seat on purely merit criteria.
- SSC & HSSC students scholarship is given to the students scoring 470 in SSC-I HSSC-I annual board examination.
- Scholarship criterion will be same for outsiders and own students (Tameerians) for SSC & HSSC students.
- Students migrated from other institutions in board classes such as SSC-II and HSSC-II, the scholarship is at discretion of Principal / Executive authorities.
- Student from other boards such as federal board seeking admission in HSSC will be given scholarship according to policy laid by college authorities.

Notes:- Scholarship scheme can be revised according to situation and there will be no alteration in this scheme on the request of parents and it can't be challenged in any court. Outsider scholarship students in HSSC-I in case of migration/transfer will be liable to pay complete /full session fee otherwise legal action will be taken. Federal and other boards student will be given scholarship according to institution policy.

EXAMINATION RULES & REGULATIONS

At the beginning of the semester, the Principal of the Institute shall announce the approximate dates of examination.

- i) The examination paper shall normally be set and marked by the teacher.
- ii) Students with less than 80% attendance in a course will not be allowed to take the examination.
- iii) For board classes (SSC & HSSC) results below 60% in detention examination lead to disqualification of students for annual board examination held in future.

RE-ADMISSION

Re admission for boarder/day scholars may be allowed at the discretion of board of Governors on payment of re admission charges settled by administration authorities. Under no circumstance will a second re admission be allowed in one academic year.

WITHDRAWAL AT PARENTS REQUEST/ DISCHARGE

A written request for withdrawing a student must reach the office well in advance i-e about a month in case of Boarders, and not less than ten days in case of Day Scholars. The school/college leaving certificate will be issued only after all the school/college dues including canteen etc, have been cleared. In case of a day scholar/day boarder, full fee for the month, and in the case of a boarder, full fee for the quarter during which the withdrawal takes place or student's name is struck off, will have to be paid. Applications for withdrawal at the end of the academic year must be submitted latest by the day the annual examination results are announced. Once a student's name has been transferred to the rolls for the next year, fee for the month of March in case of a Day Boarder / Day Scholar and for the 1st quarter in the case of Boarder, becomes payable and the school/college leaving certificate will be issued only after the same, along with the other outstanding dues, which have been met.

WITHDRAWAL/DISCHARGE BY COLLEGE ON ACADEMIC AND DISCIPLINARY GROUNDS

For withdrawal on academic and disciplinary grounds, following policy is strictly followed:

ACADEMICS:

- Continuous Failing in Monthly/Semester exams.
- Failing in One subject in Annual Examination will be liable to detention.
- If already a detainee and fails again in one subject in Annual Examination.
- Failing in any subject or securing 'C' or lesser grades in SSC Part-1 Board Examination.
- Failing in any subject or securing 'C' or lesser grades in SSC Part-2 Board Examination.
- Failing in any subject or securing 'C' or lesser grades in HSSC Part-1 Board Examination.
- For Non Board Classes failing in two subjects in annual examination merits detention in the same class.
- Board class failures in terminal and send-up exam may either repeat the class or be withdrawn on academic grounds.
- Repeated failures in monthly tests/terminal/send-up exams.

DISCIPLINE:

- Cheating in exams or in any other form.
- Committing theft.
- Grave immoral conduct.
- Smoking.
- Physical violence or attempt there of resulting in injury or having the potential to cause serious injury.
- Repetitive /prolonged absence (without leave) or bunking form classes.
- Bunking from college premises.
- Any immoral/undesirable/unbecoming conducts, while on leave.
- Willful/serious damage to college property.
- Instigating other students or acting as kind of ringleader to violated/undermine the college policies/rules/orders wherein good order and discipline of the institution is threatened/compromised.
- Any collective/group activity which is illegal / unauthorized and tends to undermine/compromise the good atmosphere of the college/state of discipline.
- Possession/use of drugs/intoxicants and weapons/knives etc.
- Any other act which is dishonorable and below the expected standards of conduct of a Hallian. Involving in agitation or instigating other students to agitate/go on strike.

- Arriving late after leave / weekends etc.
- Possessing Undesirable printed material.
- Keeping Mobile Phones (These, if confiscated, will be destroyed publicly).

Minor Offences:

Warning alongwith a fine upto 1000/- and parents call may be executed on Observation slip for committing following offences:
